### INTRODUCTION

The world's financial institutions are increasingly incorporating social, environmental and climate criteria into their investment analyses. For mining companies, this will likely translate into heightened attention and questions among investors and lenders on a project's sustainability profile. How is the project coherent with global commitments in addressing climate risks? Is its social and environmental performance consistent with best practice, such as the IFC Performance Standards or the Ecuador Principles?

This panel will explore the current dynamic between lenders, investors and mining projects in addressing social and environmental sustainability issues, and also anticipate the changes we will likely see in the next few years. With panelists from the mining and financial sectors, it will ask questions such as: How are financial actors supporting better environmental and social practices among mining companies? And, how can mining projects tap into mechanisms such as green bonds that can burnish reputations and take advantage of appetite for investments with a stronger sustainability profile?

The panel will include short opening comments from each panelist, a discussion among panelists, then a period of dialogue with participants.
